

## **UCSB Athletics Scholarship Application The UCSB Gaucho Memorial Scholarship**

### **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA**

The UCSB Gaucho Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by the family and friends of Jack Curtice to establish a permanent endowment fund in his memory. The purpose of the fund is to provide financial support to an entering or continuing undergraduate student-athlete, with priority given to those who have expended four years of eligibility at UCSB. Selection for the scholarship shall be based on athletic performance, academic achievement and evidence of community involvement.

An individual is eligible to apply for the one time scholarship support if he or she meets the established criteria. The scholarship amounts will vary annually. The scholarship will provide \$800 for the 2023-24 academic year. Student-athletes must meet all qualifications, submit all necessary documentation by the required deadline, be in good academic standing, and be enrolled full-time. As noted below, prior to an endowed scholarship being awarded, the athletic department and financial aid office will confirm the award fits within both university and NCAA financial aid individual and team limits.
